

Definition of Organic Agriculture in English¹

Organic agriculture is a production system that sustains the health of soils, ecosystems and people. It relies on ecological processes, biodiversity and cycles adapted to local conditions, rather than the use of inputs with adverse effects. Organic agriculture combines tradition, innovation and science to benefit the shared environment and promote fair relationships and a good quality of life for all involved.

"Organska poljoprivreda je takav proizvodni sistem koji održava zdravlje zemljišta, ekosistema i ljudi. On se pre zasniva na ekološkim procesima, biodiverzitetu i proizvodnim ciklusima koji su prilagođeni lokalnim uslovima, nego na upotrebi inputa sa neželjenim efektima. Organska poljoprivreda kombinuje tradiciju, inovacije i nauku u korist zajedničke životne sredine i promoviše fer odnose i dobar kvalitet života svih onih koji su uključeni u nju."
